I considered giving this book 4 stars but ultimately, I felt it deserved 5. As usual, Sidney Bristol has created complex, relatable characters stuck in extraordinary circumstances. Even secondary characters' motivations were explored. The tense plot did not go in the direction I had expected, repeatedly surprising me with unpredictable events.

I had only one complaint, and it's one that had me considering deducting a star. Dialogue. I could not decipher Ian's Irish accent. At first, I tried to read more slowly, sounding out each word. It didn't work. The missing letters and apostrophes were nonsensical to me. Less than halfway into the book, I decided that I would enjoy the book more if I just read his words as if they said what he meant to say, rather than trying to sound them out and then translate them. This meant that I didn't hear his voice, but it made for much easier reading.

As always, I recommend this book because I feel Sidney Bristol's talents as an author far outweigh any shortcomings she has as a dialogue expert. No, she is not Mark Twain, but I think it's safe to say she wasn't striving for that anyway.
