And now, she doesn't have any idea that her whole family is in a great deal of danger and her was her best hope of survival. But both Eb and Sally must battle demons from the past before they can learn to trust in love.

I enjoyed Eb's story but not as much as I enjoyed Cy Parks. Eb was your typical Diana Palmer's hero-taciturn, sexy, a lot older than the heroine, possessive but not verbally abusive to the heroine. I liked that he was sorry for the way he treated the heroine before but I totally understand why he did that. Sally was just seventeen then. But even then, Sally was important to him. She had been the first and only person who could thwart his black moods. And even she was away from home, he kept in touch with her Aunt to get nesw of Sally, of where she was, what she was doing, of her plans. I know it's kind of staking, but sweet nonetheless. He's always expected that she'd come back to him one day or that he'd go to her despite the way they'd parted.

Overall, **Mercenary's Woman** was a fun read filled with passion and danger. Plus, Jessica, Sally's Aunt and Dallas (another mercenary) love story was another interesting part of the book.
