I was surprised by how quickly I read this book, but given an anthology of fun stories with quirky superheroes, I really shouldn't be.

The reason this has 3 stars instead of 4 is a matter of personal taste. I enjoy homoerotica that is more relationship-based and has a slower build-up than can be fit into short stories of the length in this book. Also, most of the stories in this anthology were written in a very "masculine" style, and contained slews of anatomy euphemisms that were off-putting because I couldn't take them seriously. So while such word/phrase choices were amusing...I not sure amusement was what many of the authors intended me to feel in the scenes those euphemisms were used.

But as I said, my rating is a matter of personal taste. Many other stories have similar styles of physical and sexual descriptions as those in this book, and that style fits the tastes of many. Unfortunately, I'm just not one of them.

All that said, I did have fun reading this book, and will probably read *Unmasked II* when it comes out. With superheroes and homoerotica, it's hard to stray too far in the wrong direction.
