It wasn't error free and though I enjoyed it enough to overlook the typos and such, there were a few big oopsies. Both come during Cass and Wylde's second intimate scene. Two: A few sentences were repeated at the part where Cass leans down to bite Wylde. I feel a set of fresh eyes, ones that haven't looked over the story at all, would find these obvious mistakes. Every author should have a proofreader whose only job is to do the final read.
