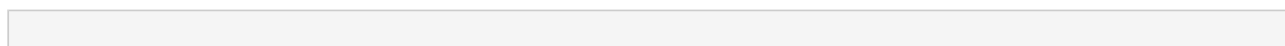

I have been waiting for Quinn's story and I certainly wasn't disappointed! Quinn isn't a fighter in the family legacy. He is the man behind the MMA gym and behind his brothers as manager and agent. He is his father's right-hand man. After his accident, Quinn questions if he wants to go back working in the family business or changing direction.

*Chasing a Legend* is the fourth book in Sarah Robinson's series entitled Kavanagh Legends. This is a sexy and sweet series for new adult romance lovers. Set in the Woodlawn neighbourhood in the borough of the Bronx in New York, we are introduced to the Kavanagh siblings. In the first three books in this series we watched three of the Kavanagh siblings fall into the throws of deep love.
