Not what I expected. When you read so many books sometimes you get a little jaded. This is the story to bring you out of the doldrums. It is full of surprises for the very beginning. This is the story of both an unconventional Omega and Alpha. How would you feel if you spent your life looking like, thinking like, & feeling like an Alpha only to be tested to in fact be an Omega? How do you cope when those feelings don't go away despite the test result? This is a really hard for the Omega, what Alpha would really want someone like him?
