I really enjoyed this, though I hope to re-read it when it's been cleaned up a bit. I got the first two volumes from Amazon (The Dark Prince and The Dark Heart) and wanted to pursue the story, so I read this and The Dark Deceit on Wattpad. I think it's safe to say that the editing process is a good thing. I enjoyed the story a lot, and I will read the next instalment with interest, but the writing was much less polished than I experienced with the first two books.

All that aside, the story is enthralling and the characters are very well drawn and enjoyable. Bram/Tully is

particularly fun -- a wannabe 'wolf' who is just too honourable to quite make it, and a highwayman who is much more Robin Hood than Dick Turpin. Corin is still larger-than-life (and getting bigger by the day) but still accessible. Laen, I find a bit opaque, which may be the point. Dannon is proving to be better than he was painted initially. Only Devil is still really despicable and scary, though Ines (another wonderful creation) clearly sees through him. The Queen/mother is also intriguingly nuanced. The girls are a bit harder to separate in my mind, perhaps because throughout the series it is mostly through their eyes that we see the story. The impact of quite so many feisty human women on a Fae society whose mores are essentially those of the nineteenth century will, I hope, provide material for many more stories Scene-setting is very good, both in 'normal' France and in Faery.

So, I heartily recommend this, and the two books that precede it, with the caveat that it will be even better when it's properly published.
