

Ryder was part of an elite military team that had been experimented on. When one of his team mates commits an atrocity, Ryder realizes it is only time before he too could snap, forcing him to leave his wife

Lauren. When he returns six months later to officially let her go, he realizes that she is in serious trouble and only he can help her.

I was instantly engaged with this story, right from the first chapter when Ryder walks into a hostage situation regardless of the consequences. The book grabbed me and never let me go. I love a good romantic suspense, and that was just what this was. I also appreciated that there was not over the top sexual encounters (sure a few hot moment's here and there but not super graphic). Most of the story dealt with the emotional turmoil between the characters mixed with near dangerous situations and investigations. There was never a dull moment in the plot and I found myself losing track of time as I read.

I liked that the book did not have to introduce the characters to each other, it started with them already married but estranged. They already knew what the other liked and had ideally planned to spend their lives together. The book alternated randomly between Lauren and Ryder's narration, which I love in a romance so that both sides are understood (by me, not necessarily each other). I really liked both characters. Lauren was feisty and refused to be a victim, an interesting mix of book smarts and spunky personality. Ryder had that tall, dark protector thing going on, but he liked that Lauren could defend herself and bragged about how smart she was. The dynamic between them was at times heartbreaking because of all the turmoil, emotional baggage and secrets between them.

I rooted for Ryder to save the day and win back Lauren (for realsies this time) and would love to read more by this author. The other team members were introduced and I can't wait for their stories as well as the underlying mystery of who is behind everything.

If you love a fast paced story filled with danger and adrenaline, this one is for you. If you love a second chance romance and a story of a couple willing to do whatever it takes to protect each other, this one is a winner. If you love a well written book that shares a story and develops as you go, keeping you guessing at what will happen, this one is what you need.

This book reads like a Jason Bourne type flick on the big screen. I could not get over how engrossed I was in the story. I love the high intensity of action and adventure. It is harder to get that fast paced story across in a written scenario without weighing the book down, but Cindy does an amazing job. As you read, you glean pieces of what has happened and learn as you go. When new details are revealed and people are introduced, it adds a new piece to the puzzle. I was always curious but never lost, just wanting to know what was coming next.

Something I appreciated about this book was the romance. This couple is married, something rare for this genre (at least from that I have read the past few years), a couple that has had their share of ups and downs but oozes obvious love, lust, and passion for each other. Ryder and Lauren are both strong in different ways. They compliment each other and the rope that connects them cannot be easily severed. Ryder's fear for Lauren causes him to question everything and attempt to fix things the only way he knows how. These two are strong headed and stubborn. This was in the script and had elements of Elite Ops - Lora Leigh (sexy times take over a lot), Hard Ink - Laura Kaye (military men having to band together to fight corruption), and Sin Brothers - Rebecca Zanetti (enhanced soldiers).

The enhanced soldiers aspect wasn't explained the best, not a lot of detail about how the hero's elite group was given a medical cocktail to not feel fear, just needed to be flushed out more to be grasped and willing to follow along. One of the hero's friends is featured a lot and the hero of the next book but the others in his group are introduced towards the end and that's all we basically get.

The hero and heroine's romance begins before the book begins (they are already married), so I definitely missed the falling in love aspect. The romance leans heavily on sexy times and "I can't live without you! But it's too dangerous to be together! But wait, I can't live without you!" that the hero ping pongs back and forth.

There's the main storyline of the hero possibly being in danger from the shady black ops company that medically enhanced him and his group and some foreclosure and meth lab criminal group that is endangering

his wife. Yeah, the foreclosure/meth storyline felt a bit unneeded and as it was the most focused on plot, I can't help but feel what was really the point since we already have a pretty interesting super soldiers and shady government company being nefarious. Obviously, we'll get more about the shady government/super soldiers storyline in the next in the series but I still feel like I didn't get enough here.

This was interesting but the other series I mentioned that this had elements from kind of did it better and since those went for many books, I have a bit of fatigue about this plot. This was well written, lacked a bit in the romance department but was entertaining, a win for a Kindle Freebie download but not really anything that was new or makes me want to rush out to buy the next in the series.

When Ryder goes inside the residence, past a pizza box with rancid smelling cheese, what does he find? What happens as he's talking to 'Mad Dog' Madigan? Who is Lauren? What's going on? Who is Smythe and why do I hate the slimeball right off the bat? What is he doing? How long has Ryder been out of pocket from Lauren? When he shows up at one of her jobs, what does she do? After her shift ends, Ryder returns, having told her he would meet her at their house. What does he find and what does he do when he returns to Lauren's work? When does he move to follow her to where she's staying with a co-worker/friend, what happens? Talk about a suspenseful situation. What information Ryder garners with Rose's help from the people at the location where he finds Lauren is unknown 1/4 of the way into the book. Though we do know that Smythe is somehow involved here. How many other teams are there? When members of Team Fear start turning up dead, what's going on? I look forward to there hopefully being a continuation of this book. It leaves on a bit of a cliffhanger, though not a traditional one.

Ryder has been in a secret military group, experimented on to create a fearless fighter and member of the group known as Team Fear. Suddenly the experiments and missions cease. Following the group's medical discharge something is happening to individuals, something Ryder fears will happen to himself, too. After trying to save one of his team involved in an armed standoff with the police, he discovers the man's wife and child have been horrendously killed just before the blood covered team mate commits suicide, shooting himself in front of Ryder. Fearing he too may become as dysfunctional and because he truly loves his wife, Lauren, without explaining to her, he disappears from her life trying to protect her from himself but leaving her vulnerable to the machinations of others and unknowingly placing her in greater danger. When he returns to check up on her, the action hots up in every sense of the term! She is intelligent, feisty and devastated by his disappearance and the loss of their home, struggling to continue her studies whilst working two jobs. Can she trust him to remain? Dare she?

With kidnapping, murder, attempted murder, fraud and so much more this is a fast paced, gritty thriller, a real page turner that keeps you enthralled. The characters are well developed, their dialogue believable and, at times, just so realistic that it is funny.
