

Unspeakable Lies is a New Adult Contemporary Romance told from the point of view of the heroine, Everly, who you first meet in the full length novel, *Unspeakable Truths*. It is recommended that in order to fully understand what happens within this companion novella that you first take the time to read Unspeakable Truths.

When I signed up to review this story, the blurb really drew me in, so wanting to know more, I also requested the first story so that I could get the fully effect of these characters and the what if situation that was presented within the pages of this one.

I was not in the slightest bit disappointed. Picking up where Unspeakable Truths began, we're thrown right back in time with this story, but with a twist. Tyler, who Everly truly believes is the love of her life, didn't die they day they were married and in fact lives on with Luca (the hero from the first story), back completely in the Tyler friend zone with Everly none the wiser to everything that happened before.

It was my hope reading this one, especially with as moved as I was with the way the previous story ended that in some way, Luca and Everly would find their way back to each other and that the happy ending they both so richly deserved could be recreated again here, solidifying their relationship and somehow making it even stronger than ever before.

Again I was not disappointed.

Because I had become invested in these characters before, it was like coming home again reading this one (because I did read another book in between) and I felt for them all much the same as I did when I finally turned the last page on their previous story. At times, with Everly identifying with her even more than I had before and feeling for her as these horrible secrets about the man she stood before family and friends and married came to light, but in a much different way because she was doing it while he was still among the living.

One line in this story stood out more than any other and even after finishing the story and now reflecting back, still does.

"If people think I'm wrong, then so be it; it's easy to judge someone when you haven't experienced their pain."

At the time she was reflecting on her feelings for Luca, while still technically being married to Tyler, but was the realest and rawest thought that I think I read through the entire story and there were quite a few other lines that I loved as I read along. It was like in that moment despite her concerns and fears about how they began, she was giving herself permission to love Luca without reservation and it was beautiful.

The pacing of this story, because it was shorter in nature was perfect. There were no lulls or moments where everything didn't run together, which made it much like the first story in that it was easy to devour.

Overall, this was a very unique idea in Unspeakable Truths (learning to love again and accept it after loss), that was flipped on its axis and explored in a different way to see if two people destined to be together, could be if the situations and circumstances were changed and it hit its mark beautifully.

By stories end I got my payoff, for the second time and I couldn't be happier. Even if to get there my heart and my eyes had to shed quite a few tears over the serious situations that the characters found themselves in and the concern and momentary panic I had at one specific moment throughout.

My hat is off to the author for creating a wonderful story full of love, loss, acceptance, growth, change and in the end happiness. It was a beautiful journey to get to Luca and Everly's end and I'm so glad that I was lucky enough to come along for the ride.
