Matt has been a key character in the previous two books. He was waiting for Celeste to return. She was the last piece of the puzzle. I was so happy to finally see him paired with one of the sisters. Matt remained strong and steadfast in a time when none of them knew exactly what was going to happen. Celeste was the wild card for me in this story. I wasn't sure what powers she had or what her personality was like. But her affinity for the spirit animals, her gentleness, and her love for her family really won me over. I think she is my favorite of all the sisters. The fact that we got to learn so much more about Granny this time as well fleshed out the story more and allowed me to connect with Celeste more than the others.

The planet of Glory itself was a character in its own right in this book. The torment and disease that had rocked the forests was spreading wider. The pools were the healers trying to bring it all back into balance. It was a tempestuous and unreliable element in the story. As I read the story I felt the uneasiness of being in the black part of the forest or in the middle of the electrical storms. You could almost smell the rain...
