

Delores Fossen pretty much writes the same book over and over again. It seems like every single male in the extended Ryland family has a one-night-stand in their past who they get reunited with, and who always has custody of some baby that's in danger. WHAT IS WRONG WITH THIS FAMILY?!? But Fossen has found a formula that works for her, and she's sticking to it!

The action and suspense in this was great! Top-notch. The mystery was a bit convoluted (as it usually is with a Fossen book), but it was fast-paced, non-stop action from start to finish, and Fossen always does a good job of providing a handful of suspects, all with motives to be the culprit behind all the mayhem. It actually makes it hard to pick out the villain!

However, the romance was a bust. I was never convinced that Landon had any real feelings towards Tessa. He spends most of the book accusing her of sleeping with any man whose name she happens to mention, or of withholding information deliberately (despite having freaking amnesia), and constantly harassing her to tell him everything she knows, when she's still trying to remember herself. He was such a dickhead! I didn't like him much at all. Because the plot's so busy, Fossen has to tell us that they totally dig each other, because their words and actions really don't convey that. As for Tessa, she's not unlikable, but she is pretty bland. Her friend Courtney was a much more interesting and kick-ass character.

Also, because this is part of a series, several characters from previous books are heavily involved. And this is book 9. I had trouble keeping all the brothers and cousins apart. I could have done without that, because I also had to keep track of all the other characters who could possibly be involved in wanting Tessa dead!

This would make a great low-budget action movie! But if you want romance as well, you'll probably be disappointed! "Mercy" word count: 9

An exciting return to Silver Creek. Landon has given up his job in the city police department to return home to Silver Creek and become part of the sheriff's department there. He wants to help find out who murdered one of his cousins, leaving a note on the body that "this one's for you, Landon". A prime suspect is Tessa Sinclair, in whose house the body was found, and who is currently missing. Not something he wants to hear about a woman he had gotten very close to.

Leaving Emmet's funeral, Landon discovers an abandoned barn on fire, and Tessa's unconscious body inside. He barely gets her out in time, only to find that she is also holding a newborn baby. Stunned to see her and a baby, Landon has questions for her that Tessa is unable to answer.

When Tessa regains consciousness she has no idea who she is, where she is, or what has happened to her. After a trip to the hospital, a blow to the head and a body full of drugs explains how, but not why. Her memory begins to return, but there are holes in it.

From here begins a wild ride of a story. Someone shoots at Landon and Tessa before they even leave the hospital, and again at the sheriff's office. As Tessa remembers more, she tells Landon that she had been looking for proof that her boss was involved in something crooked. There's a federal agent she's been working with who she isn't sure is on the up-and-up. She is also caring for the infant daughter of a friend, who is running from an abusive ex. For his part, Landon has the murder of his cousin, which appears to be tied to him. And the belief that one of his former arrests, now out on parole, is responsible for it. The question becomes, are the two cases linked somehow?

It seems that Landon and Tessa can barely catch a break. Attacks on them come fast and furious as they try to find out who is trying to kill her. And what does baby Samantha have to do with any of it? There are multiple persons of interest, leading to great confusion over just what is going on. There is Joel, Tessa's former boss, who may be guilty of anything from drug trafficking to murder. There is Quincy, the felon that Landon locked up, who is now free on parole. He was injured in a prison fight and is confined to a wheelchair, but that hasn't improved his attitude any. Then Ward, who is supposed to be one of the good guys, but seems awfully intent on putting the blame on Tessa. And who is Courtney, and who is really little Samantha's father? The final confrontation was intense, with enough twists and turns to make me dizzy. I wasn't sure from one minute to the next who was really responsible, though I did have my suspicions.

Throughout it all, the attraction they felt before continues to grow. Landon isn't happy about it because he's not so sure she can be trusted, at least at first. He's also too intent on his investigation to want a relationship. Tessa knows she can trust him (at least after the drugs have worn off) but believes that she is putting him in danger. I loved seeing them try to protect each other as things blew up around them, and their feelings grow in spite of the danger. Tessa admits to her feelings first, but it's Landon's realization, and his cousins' reactions and comments that I liked most. I loved the ending.

I loved seeing all the Rylands together as they worked to solve the case. It seemed like old times, right down to Mason's grumpiness and Grayson's leadership.

Landon is the ninth book in The Lawmen of Silver Creek Ranch series but it's the first novel in this series that I've read, and I wish I'd known that at the time I requested to read and review it because even with the introductory cast of characters, most of whom share the last name Ryland, between them and the multitude of suspects and ski-mask wearing thugs, I found it hard to keep them all straight without a scorecard, something that would not have been the case had I been reading this series from its beginning.

As the novel opens, Landon Ryland, a deputy sheriff, is at the funeral of his recently murdered cousin Emmett, scanning the gathered crowd for possible suspects and hoping to spot Tessa Sinclair, in whose home Emmett's body was found and pinned to his body was a note reading, "This is for you, Landon". She and Landon had a brief affair in one of the earlier novels and apparently it didn't end well. On the way back to the sheriff's office, Landon spots smoke and when he stops to investigate, it's a barn fire, obviously arson, but the last thing he expects to find is Tessa's unconscious body near the flames and even more surprising is the newborn baby she's got wrapped in her arms. Could it be his? When she comes to, she has no idea who Landon is, whether or not the baby is hers, not even her own name. She's got a large lump on her head and by the time they get her to the hospital, they learn that she's also been heavily drugged, which certainly explains her memory loss. The timing is right for the baby, Samantha, to possibly be Landon's child if Tessa is the mother, but is she? So many questions and no easy answers. What follows is an action-packed thriller/mystery with enough suspects, possible motives and shoot-em-ups than a hardcore western, and as the questions keep piling up, so too do the attempts on Tessa's life, the attempts to kidnap the baby, the attempts to learn who her father is, and the search for Courtney, who we learn early on is the mother of baby Samantha. It was Courtney who begged her neighbor Tessa to keep her baby safe, but again, we're not sure why, or whether Courtney is an innocent in all this or if she's Emmett's lover or his murderer.

If you're looking for action and suspense, this novel will keep you riveted, but I strongly suggest starting this series from the very beginning, as that will certainly prevent the confusion experienced by this reader. As for the romance part of "romantic suspense," there's an HEA ending but not much romance or character and relationship development leading up to it.
