They're standalones but it feels like a treat whenever I see cameos of previous MCs. Also, it feels realistic because even though Metro Manila has a population of almost 12 million (according to Wikipedia), it still feels like such a small world sometimes.

I started reading *Wedding Night Stand* past midnight last Sunday. You might be wondering why I would start a book that late when I would have to wake up early the next day for work. That's because I was in denial that the weekend is over. Anyway, this was the perfect choice because I was able to finish it in one go. And I didn't have to give up that much sleeping time for it.
