One of the prime difficulties in writing this type of book is putting equal amounts of adventure with the emotions of an every day existence. Luckily, this is what Schatz does so effectively. In the changing points of view, each teen gets his or her moment to talk not just about what they're doing on their adventures, but the real-life moments of pain and joy that characterize everyone's life.

The only reason this book got 4 stars instead of five is that sometimes those moments of every day life came with humor that was a little forced, a little unrealistic of what teens actually make jokes about. That one criticism aside, there are just as many genuinely funny moments to make up for it.

It's a book that's adventure and exhilaration and emotion, and it's the type of book that heals as well as comforts. I can't wait to see what else Schatz has planned for Rory, Tima, Billy, and James!
