We were briefly introduced to Sabrina as Alexandra's feisty cousin in Mr. Buff. Sabrina has been harboring a serious lust-fueled crush on her boss, Maxwell Stone for about a year. So far she's done a really good job of keeping her raging desire for him in check, not just because his company has a strict no fraternization policy, but he's also her boss, and everyone knows that sleeping with the boss is never a good idea. While on a colleague bonding retreat in the woods, a very inebriated Sabrina can't resist the heated looks or the feel of a mere touch from Max.
