When Special Agent Constance Mandalay arrived in Hulis three days before Christmas thirty five years later, she was met by Sheriff Carmichael. She was following in the footsteps of four other FBI agents who had come to investigate the phenomenon which had been occurring every Christmas for the past seven years.
