My original review, many years ago, began with "Quite a good missal." Having scrolled through my reviews I can't believe how wrong I was.

The missal is simply cheap. And when you have to mass-produce a book with over 2000 pages, is it any wonder that shortcuts are taken? The paper is very thin and cheap, the text isn't pleasing to read. The binding is poor, the cover even worse. It feels terrible to hold. It lacks many of the distinct elements that make missals beautiful.

To some extent this isn't the publisher's fault; they have to publish at a low price point a very large book. And if that's all you want - a cheap daily missal - then it might suffice for you. Keep in mind that it uses the NAB, the proper translation for America, and practically no other English speaking nation. But having experienced using other daily missals and speaking with others and their experience, it simply falls short.
