The Son follows Four as he struggles to find his place in the hierarchy of Dauntless. We see him train for a leadership position mentioned in Divergent, and why he really made the choice of becoming an instructor instead.

Someone's breaking into his new room, leaving an unnamed note at the same time Four starts suspecting foul play and Jeanine Matthews seems to be stopping by more often.
