Then in The End Note we found out he was officially a man of the military, but basically on loan to Cole Enterprises. So in other words he's bad ass. Well we finally get his story in If Ever I Fall, and that makes me incredibly happy. This story takes place in Scotland, which made me a very happy woman. I have a soft spot for books wrote in Scotland and Ireland for some reason, so this was perfect for me. Aiden goes with Cole Enterprises to set up shop in Scotland to try and gain Intel on the criminal Robert de Fleur, aka the guy who kidnapped Jared. Garrett, Nadia, and Aiden set up shop in the basement of the local church. Aiden goes "undercover" working in a coffee shop owned by de Fleur's sister Brenda. Cole Enterprises is hoping to gain knowledge of de Fleur's whereabouts since he is underground.

Aiden doesn't learn anything from Brenda, except for the knowledge he can't work the fancy coffee machines, and learns the different kinds of tea. Then one day Airen comes home, Brenda's niece. To say there was an instant attraction would be an understatement.
