In *The Dead and the Beautiful (a Nikki Harper Mystery)*, Cheryl Crane reacquaints readers with Nikki Harper, the daughter of a famous movie star from the golden days of Hollywood, Victoria Bordeaux. The story opens when Victoria hosts a garden party. There, Nikki meets "Disney's Fab Four," young stars who had made it big a few years earlier when they co-starred in a Disney sitcom. When Ryan Melton, the husband of one of the Fab Four shows up dead a short time later, Alison, the sister of Nikki's love interest, is accused of the murder. Nikki follows the clues to uncover the real culprit in an attempt to support Alison in much the way that Victoria had supported Nikki years earlier when Nikki herself had been accused of a murder.

As the daughter of Lana Turner, Cheryl Crane is uniquely qualified to tell the story of an adult child of a Hollywood star. With a "smile" ingrained in Nikki since childhood—one that is not fake, just "rehearsed"—Nikki is at home among the rich and famous. Readers will enter Nikki's world, as Crane surrounds them with designer handbags, shoes and clothing, posh and beautiful homes and home furnishings, and Hollywood's elite, in *The Dead and the Beautiful*. In the midst of this world of wealth and fame, Nikki befriends people who, enamored with the fame of her mother, are eager to assist Nikki as she attempts to solve the mystery. All the while, readers will be drawn closer and closer to the ultimate question: will Nikki identify the real murderer before she becomes the next victim?

However life gets complicated when Jeremy's sister, Alison, is accused of murdering a young actresses' husband, Ryan Melton. It seems like there is no reason that Alison should be accused of murder, apart from the fact that Ryan was strangled with a dog leash and Alison walks Melton's dog in her job as a dog walker to the stars. However as Nikki starts to investigate she learns secrets about the young stars of her mother's tv show and also about Alison's past that make her question what she thought she knew.

If anyone has the credentials and experience to write a mystery set in Hollywood it is surely Cheryl Crane. Cheryl is the daughter of Lana Turner, the popular actress in the 40s and 50s. As I was reading The Dead and

the Beautiful I saw a lot of Lana Turner and Cheryl Crane in the mother and daughter duo, Victoria Bourdeaux and Nikki Harper. Victoria is a Hollywood icon and together the pair make a great detective duo.

The author's experience in Hollywood certainly carries through in The Dead and the Beautiful and I found myself wrapped up in a realistic mystery about the stars of Hollywood that I could imagine gracing the tabloids. Ryan Melton is the arm-candy husband of Disney superstar, Diara, and I liked how the Disney stars are dubbed as the "Fab Four".

And as often happens, what especially annoyed me was that the motive for the murder wasn't found out until nearly the end of the book. Also, there seemed to be several references to this author's previous books about this character, and whereas it doesn't seem as important in other cozy mysteries to read as "stand alone", in this one, I felt it really made a difference if you'd read previous books (I hadn't).

This is Book 3 in this author's "Nikki Harper" series. After enjoying the previous book in this series I was looking forward to this one. Happily, it did not disappoint. I normally enjoy cozy mysteries and, while the setting for this story was not in a small town, it had many elements of a cozy mystery. The main character and amateur sleuth is Nikki Harper – real estate broker and daughter of legendary actress Victoria Bordeaux. The victim in this story is Ryan Melton. He is only famous for being the husband of actress Diara Elliott. Victoria and Diara are currently working on the same TV show. Nikki gets involved because the chief suspect for police is dog walker to the wealthy and famous, Alison Sahira. She is the sister of Nikki's boyfriend. She is also a mother trying to retain custody of her teenage daughter and of a slightly nervous temperament. Although never particularly close, Nikki doesn't believe Alison is a murderess and that she needs somebody to be in her corner. Her empathy comes from drawing a parallel between Alison's situation she currently finds herself, and an incident in Nikki's past. Her constant defense of Alison is a source of contention between Nikki and her boyfriend Jeremy. He has trouble believing his sister because of criminal activity in her past. It's not so much what part she played in what happened long ago that bothers him, but that she lied about it. As with the previous book, I loved Victoria. She is such a class act, and I love her relationship with Nikki and also what she brings to the story. I also like Nikki's hot but gay movie star buddy Marshall Thunder. He is a fun character and a great friend. I like how the author once again makes it seem plausible that Nikki would get involved in this murder case, and her ability to get information from witnesses. Nikki's status and connections really come in handy in this case, since the main players in the murder mystery are Hollywood movers and shakers. The mystery itself kept me guessing and kept me interested from start to finish. Nikki is very relatable, likable, and grounded, in spite of her privileged

background. I loved the chemistry between her and Lieutenant Detective Tom Dombrowski, or as Nikki refers to him – Detective Cutie-Pants. It's not that I really dislike her current boyfriend. I just feel like she has more chemistry with Tom, so I'm hoping they might be a couple in the future. The resolution to the mystery was interesting and satisfying. I can't wait for the next book in the series!
