

The plot is an spine tingling suspense that is full of twists and turns.

This is the third book in the series, but is easily a stand alone. I would recommend reading the first two books to get the full impact of the series.

This story centers around Olivia Kendrick, Rich Kendrick and Zach Long.

Rich and Zach are best friends. Rich was engaged to Zach's sister Sarah until she was killed 3 years ago. Rich was devastated and hired on with a private military contractor in the middle east to put some distance between him and the tragedy. Olivia was a biology teacher in Portland, but with the death of her mother retreated to the vacation home located outside of Giddeon in the Siskiyou Mountains. She went to work for Wilderness, Inc. as a guide for the adventure excursion company. Zach Long was a Portland Police Detective until a year ago when he resigned from the job. I loved Olivia and Zach. Olivia is a strong woman who has learned to depend on no one but herself. She has a gentle heart and a warm personality. Zach comes from a long line of police officers in the family so he's a natural born protector.

From the first page as Oliva finds a trail of blood in the snow, I was swept into this story. Goddard writes in such a way that the cold of the snow and blizzard seeped into me as I went along for the ride. But the heart of this story lies in regrets.
