I have a lot of contradicting feelings about this book.

Let's start with what I did like:

- The parts of the couple together were nice, but... I couldn't shake the feeling it was a complete fantasy and that's it.
- It was an easy read, I could get into the feel of the novel fairly quickly.
- It's kind of addicting if that's what you like in books (guilty pleasures).
- Beckenham used words I rarely read so I my.

What I didn't like:

- It was the bare bones of a novel. I felt that I'm reading one of the early drafts and now going to tell her how to improve it.

The plot is so flimzy, predictable, and had nothing to it. I knew where things are going (which is a reason to take my mind off of what is actually happening in the novel), but it was so weird and wonky. The plot was not smooth and seamless, gliding us from one plot point to the next. No. It was very troubled. And sometimes I just did not know what was happening and what the characters wanted to do. Which brings me to my next point.

- The characters. They were weird, boring and at times inconsistent, especially Taylor. She wanted to kiss him but then a thought of her dead fiancé of four years had crossed her mind and turned her cold, in the middle of everything. Sometimes I wasn't able to even know what popped in her head that made her cold but it wasn't triggered by anything that went on around her. Suddenly she loves Cade, and she wants him to be with her, completely, so she wears exposing clothing and decides to convince him to be together and suddenly she is walking out on him, why? Because she wants him to choose her. When they are dancing and he can't keep his eyes off her trying to be with her... And she leaves. And Cade - every time we get his point of view his character changes and becomes more like Taylor as in thoughts and the way he speaks. Inconsistent.

- The beginning. Thank god I read the summary of the book before I actually read the book itself because otherwise I would understand nothing. It was like the author tried the approach of dropping us straight into the water, but did not give us life-jackets so we drowned in the infinite sea of no context. It had taken me so many pages to understand something more about the characters. It felt a bit like a teen girl's fantasy. Moreover, because we started on such high note without building tension the rest of the novel suffered. Do you want to read a tension building romantic novel about a one time between a wedding planner and a bar owner? Read "Knight In Shining Suit" by Jerilee Kaye, for the most part you won't regret it.

- The ending. Connected to the characters part I didn't like - Cade, that is - he suddenly wants not only being with her, but marriage (mind you, they were known about the others existence for a month, maybe, when they were together for a week in total), and KIDS?!!
