Continuing my "armchair vacation" to Key West, Florida via these deliciously fun and very suspenseful culinary cozy murder mysteries from phenomenally talented author and publisher Summer Prescott, book 2 in her absolutely delectable Key West culinary mystery series – Key Lime Die – has pie shop owner Marilyn and her daughter Tiara faced with stiff – and unethical – Competition from a rival pie shop which, having never before served it, is now featuring key lime pie as it's newest signature dessert offering. Not only this, but a representative from Joseph's Slice of the Pie is seen passing out glossy promotional fliers right in front of Sublime Sweets (Marilyn's beloved pie shop). Amidst a flurry of blatantly vicious – and quite unethical – maneuvers to seduce Marilyn's customers away from Sublime Sweets and directly to Joseph's Slice of the Pie, Marilyn and her daughter Tiara are desperate to keep their pie shop afloat and in business. Everything hits rock bottom for Marilyn and Kiara when, after literally staying up all night baking 75 key lime pies for a last minute emergency wedding order, when the woman who placed the order never shows up to claim and pay for the pies, a desperate and severely sleep-deprived Marilyn collapses under the weight of her desperate frustration and makes a "revenge pie" for rival pie shop owner Joseph., which she considers presenting to him under the guise of a peace offering. By morning, however, well-rested once again, Marilyn recognizes that nothing good can come from her sleep-deprived revenge plan and immediately nixes the whole thing, as common sense returns with the clear-headedness of once more being well-rested. Unfortunately, stopping by her mother's house and seeing the pie (which appears to be any other beautiful key lime pie that Marilyn would bake) – along with Marilyn's cheery pink note offering peace – Tiara (believing she is helping her mother) delivers the "revenge pie" unknowingly to Joseph's pie shop. When she awakens and discovers what her daughter has done, Marilyn heads for Joseph's shop to set things right – only to discover a swarm of police cars on the premises. Soon she learns – much to her horror – that her arrival pie shop owner is dead... allegedly from an extreme allergic reaction to tree nuts. Worse still, her pie is suspected to be the source of the deadly and fatal ingredients. And, once again, Marilyn finds herself to be the prime suspect in yet another murder investigation...
