

Wow! Jessie Donovan totally rocked my world - again with The Dragon's Heart, the third release in her amazingly popular Lochguard Highland Dragons Series. I've been a diehard Jessie Donovan fan for years and eagerly await each new release but I must admit, I was more excited than usual about this particular book and I think it may be my favorite to date! Many of us are paranormal romance fans but we all know most romance stories feature young love and by that I mean, they almost always feature young adults.
