I've been looking forward to reading *Blood Lust* ever since I finished the *Lady of Toryn* trilogy by Charity Santiago. Luckily, I didn't have long to wait for this one! *Blood Lust* is an great start to an awesome new paranormal series. I love paranormal, so I knew I'd love this. The characters are unique, and the plot flows so well. Grab this one ASAP, you won't regret it!

Eve Samuels isn't having an amazing atmosphere at home on account of her parents' divorce, so she decides to move to her Grandma's house in Rapid City, and attend National American University there. Eve's got it all planned out, but she gets a few unexpected surprises. Eve's an awesome protagonist, and I liked her immediately. She's responsible but at the same time really fun.
