In the Novel *Secrets Of My Hollywood Life On Location*, Jen Calonita talks about the life of an actress named Kaitlin Burke who has to deal with a lot of problems involving the fame and glamour of being famous. She also falls in love with a normal boy named Austin Meyers and has to balance both her relationship and career. Not to mention she has to make a good impression on Austin's parents. All while her ex-boyfriend and enemy Daniella tries to destroy her role in the Hutch Adams movie; which could either end or help her career. In the bestseller *Secrets of My Hollywood life: On Location* by Jen Calonita, one girl named Kaitlin will embark on a journey through her crazy and busy life as a teen soap star. Kaitlin will have some tension with one other teen star named Sky Mackenzie who is out for the same role in an upcoming blockbuster movie. Kaitlin will have a rocky relationship with her boyfriend Austin who is a lacrosse prodigy at normal high school and a fake relationship with Drew Thomas who is the male lead in her movie. Meanwhile, because of her celebrity status Kaitlin will have to balance a "normal life" with her press parties. This is complicated by the decision of whether or not to follow her heart or her publicist: whether to bring her small town boy or her teen star fake boyfriend to these parties. She will have her assistants plan and help her through it all.

In the novel I reacted to very strongly to the main character Kaitlin. She has a caring and smart personality; she tries to think of her friends and family instead of herself. Kaitlin does so when her best friend Liz was in need of a summer job and gives her a job as her second assistant "I've been on all of Kaitlin's summer shoots. I help her run lines, organize her fan mail, and bring hot tea..." (54). Kaitlin says to her "You're like my second assistant" (54). Kaitlin makes mistakes and admits when she is wrong just like any other teen. She is like any normal teenager except in the eye of paparazzi. Kaitlin wants to balance everything and she will break at some points but get back up and keep trying like anyone else.

Overall, I thought this book accurately portrays the struggles of a young Hollywood actress. I thought it was
