

We met Will in A Cry for Hope. He is Jamie's playboy, firefighter, younger brother. Will knows how life can change in an instant so he is determined to live it to the fullest and do what he wants when he wants. He holds himself back and has limited true connections with women and even with his own family.

When Will ends up in the hospital, he meets burn nurse, Gabby. She brings a little happiness to his days as

he is recovering. Her life is also in a rut and she feels powerless to change it. All she really has going for her is her work.

These two lost souls develop a witty, engaging rapport that turns into a true friendship that builds at a realistic pace. They truly begin to look out for the other and provide balance. They become friends who could read each other so well in some ways and were so clueless in others.
