

I absolutely loved the His Fair Assassins trilogy. I thought Grave Mercy was good, but not life changing, Dark Triumph was absolutely amazing and Sybella was my total hero. I bawled after this book. And I really loved Mortal Heart just for how unexpected it was. So when I saw Robin LaFevers was returning to this world, I knew I had to get my hands on Courting Darkness.

We've been told that this is a standalone duology in this world and that you don't need to read the previous books to read the duology. I have to disagree.

Like I mentioned previously, Sybella is an amazing character and I love to see that she is front in center in this next installment. Her love story with Beast is one of the best parts of Dark Triumph. But if you don't have that history, Courting loses a lot of its punch. Courting Darkness takes place right after Mortal Heart ends in the timeline, so everything that has been building up in the first three books continues in this installment. Characters from the first three books fill up the pages, the political intrigue picks up right where we stopped, and the way even the assassins work isn't dwelled on. I believe that it should be called the fourth book in the series.

I worry that new followers will not be grabbed by the story because they don't know Sybella and Beast like we do. And Courting Darkness is well worth the read, but the history counts.

We are introduced to another new important character, who has been seemingly abandoned by the convent. Slowly, as this book is a slow burn, we realize her importance. But do not expect for Sybella to meet her in this book.

So this is the issue-- I loved this book, but the way it was presented does it a disservice to both old fans of the series and new ones as well. It also definitely felt more like the first half of a long book rather than a book in its own right.

While I will for sure pick up the next book, I urge others to start with Grave Mercy and work their way through all the books prior to Courting Darkness. It's worth the journey but it's a longer one than you were expecting to take.
