Bear is beige. (grrr)
Frog is green. (ribbit)
Monkey is brown. (ooo-ooo-eee-eee)
Elephant is gray. (eee-ooo)
Octopus is orange. (blub blub)
Porcupine is black. (prickly!)
Armadillo is brown and white. (i don't know their noise)

I was surprised when I realized that we own another book by the author (If You're Happy and You Know It), but could see the same style in the illustrations. There is a variety in the animals the kitty hugs (peacock, armadillo, mouse) without leaving out favorites (elephant, bear). I liked the unexpected choice of her baby brother being her favorite hug. The bold black text and simple format make the book appropriate for teaching print

awareness skills. Children may also learn new adjectives with each kind of animal.
