

The chapter on APA references is superb and the section on rhetorical situations clear and concise.

As it is relatively light on readings, it is best for teachers who stress a writing-workshop class format. The readings it does have provide useful examples of expert and novice writing. My only other complaint, if that, is that in its efforts to be readable it comes off as somewhat repetitive.

The other huge bonus: it's far cheaper than many 111 textbooks! My students pay only about \$40 online and in the campus bookstore.
