And the Valkyrie portion of the story just seemed like your basic origin story with a million background facts thrown at the reading audience, the usual gaining of odd powers, gaining new surrounding people (which all blended since they all seemed to have the same loud personality), the usual introduction of a hot dark mysterious guy, the usual introduction of a new world, and the usual revelation that she's especially special within that world. And then the story devolved even further into a teen drama where several teenage boys squabbled over the heroine after she spent several pages trying on clothes. Granted, I was less than impressed by them since I've gotten beyond bored with shifters and packs.
