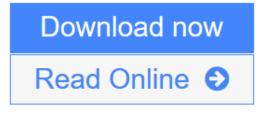

Derrick and Marcia love their little community of friends. If only they had a place to call their own. In OPEN DOORS, Ms. Dalton shows what it takes to open a BDSM club. Many books have high end clubs for the rich and privileged. I'm not saying that these don't exist. They just happen to be far fewer than it appears in BDSM glitterkink books. Personally, I have been at the start of when a community of kinksters tried to open their own club in a building. Due to several variables and one of them a zoning issue, the club was closed down. So when I read about how Derrick and Marcia open up a club and how it starts out, I'm impressed.

Ms. Dalton does a great job of showing how a club grows organically through contributions from the entire community. As the community grows, more people help out through service or donations of furniture. Seeing a place grow from ground up is a special experience. The frustrations and heads are worth it.

I loved the accuracy of the book. I loved how there are men with great plans and forget about the details. Showing how a dominant husband's relationship works with a business savvy submissive wife is a great representation of how D/s dynamics can work in real life. At the end we are introduced to a new character which will lead us into the next book in the series, One Ring.

The book reads like a primer on how to open a BDSM club. Lots of information about painting, renting, rules, legal problems, etc. (Honestly, not what I was expecting)

Perhaps most noteworthy is it shows the relationship between a dom and a very strong submissive. Reading about the relationship between Derrick and Marcia was interesting as their dynamic was odd in comparison to most BDSM books. Derrick's role as a dom was 99% in the bedroom. Mentally, I really didn't identify him

as a dom because his wife made the decision about pretty much everything and decided when/where they were going to play. He deferred to her in pretty much every situation. He even lied to her several times to avoid confrontation about the decision he had made and she laid down the law about what she expected from him in the future. Even other characters in the book commented that he was not being much of a dom. I thought it clearly demonstrated that relationships, even kinky relationships, don't always fit in neat little boxes nor can they be clearly labeled or understood by those not involved.
