Cute story about two girls whose mom can't get them to clean up their room. She tells them she's going to contact the Gunny Sack Man, who will eat up their toys and clothes if they aren't put away. If the room is clean, however, he's leave them a present, usually a treat. The girls rush to clean up their room, and lo and behold, they end up with a treat under their pillows. Fun rhyming test and colorful pages will attract any child's attention.

The illustrations are not well done. The story however is very cleaver, a great way to get children to clean. This is like a cleaning version of the tooth fairy, brilliant. A level one activity would be to have the children actually clean. Putting the book into practice would be great. You can make it academically tied to Blooms, by having the children list what they put away, and the children get a treat or a treat for each thing that is spelled correctly. The gunny sac man could say "I can't eat a tran", if train is spelled incorrectly. I want to do this one in my class.
