A few samples: "This kiss could take out a freaking power grid, it's that powerful."

"I want him to turn up the voltage and I don't care what kind of watts he is using--I just want to be plugged into him."

And right before they're about to get it on for the first time (just after they met)... "I blink, looking into his soulful baby blues. 'I'm no saint,' I tell him. 'I've done this before.' 'So have I. But girl, never with you.'"
