personal toy. Then she breaks his heart. Then, she meets some trouble with the press, and he calls her. He comes over and makes a homemade dinner for her and they spend the night together and she breaks his heart AGAIN. Then, she calls him during the Superbowl and begs him to come over. For some unimaginable reason he agrees. They have a cute, sweet, romantic Superbowl-watching night. Aw. I like this. THEN... WAIT FOR IT... She breaks his heart again!!!! Wash, rinse repeat.
