The plot is well thought and holds a great pace. I really liked the fact that it has this air of mystery throughout the scorching and very detailed descriptions of nights at the club. The Pleasure Room hits "the scene" with accuracy and respect, something that won huge points with me. The kink certainly runs deep in this story with a little bit of everything, a lot of attention was paid to detail (a HUGE plus) .

The Pleasure Room ... just like the name implies is a story of an ambitious rookie journalist and the BDSM Master who shows her how to shed her inhibitions and finally find herself.

There is a sub plot which is interesting. Rookie journalist trying to gather facts regarding the Chicago Mayor with a taste for kink, while playing the family man to win his re-election. This is what drives Felicity to the BDSM club initially. What she finds there is shocking, intriguing and titillating to her, in addition to the willing Master and owner of the club, Sir Alistair. The sound of his British accent is only one of the many attractions she finds. The man is full of charisma and gentle dominance on the surface. His willingness to introduce her to the lifestyle is just one perk she cannot pass up. This also opens the doors to the sex club where the Mayor frequently carries on his trysts with Mistress V. The only thing left is to coordinate how Felicity can film the Major in less than "family oriented positions" so she can bring him down. Lives are threatened, some don't make it, and through it all the main theme remains the introduction of Felicity to Alistair's lifestyle.

This book was interesting, erotic, and instructional. It does go deeper into the BDSM lifestyle than I have read before. There are some very strong, raw scenes ... but you must remember this is erotica with a plot line. This is not sex just for the sake of writing a titillating story. There she meets the club's owner, Alistair, an upper class Brit who is a dominant. He recognizes the submissive in her and goes about having her make a contract with him. She falls in love with him, but how can there possibly be a relationship outside of sex when she has lied to him about her name, what she

was doing in that club, and has kept it from him since? Will Felicity get her story? Will she choose love? Can both happen without annihilating the other?

This book is a good read for those who like erotica. It has a sound plot, good action, and D.N. Simmons' masterful writing that depicts the camaraderie of deep-rooted friendship and companionship. This depiction is what made me love her Knights of the Dark chronicles books. The relationship between Allison and Felicity, best friends and co-workers, made me smile and often laugh. Allison certainly has a mouth on her and likes to just say what she is thinking. I loved when she took Alistair to task unapologetically. I went in to this book not knowing really what to expect since I have never read this author before, but the blurb sucked me in and I was instantly intrigued. I will admit that, yes, I thought it was going to be similar to 50 Shades of Grey (Which I LOVED by the way) and I am glad to say that, yes it had it's similarities, but it was a totally different type book. The main similarity is the Dom/sub relationship that the characters enter into, but truly that is where the similarities end. In some ways the Dom/sub BDSM theme of this book is what I expected 50 Shades to be like. What I found amazing was that even with all the sex and BDSM aspects, there was still an amazing storyline and love story.
