Tough for me - 3.5 Stars

This was a tough one in all honesty. I love all of Yumo's books but this one missed the mark for me. I was teetering between a 3 and 4 star rating. I like the idea of the story and the guys in the harem a lot. I didnt mind Destiny as much, but I couldn't connect with her as much. I think Cole stole the show handedly. His background and his feelings were fantastic and engaging and his kissing Destiny on her forehead was absolutely adorable, which made me give it a 4 star rating on here instead of a 3 star.

I think my issue was certain phrases or feelings of characters became pretty repetitive, mostly with Destiny. It kept taking me out of the story and had me skipping some paragraphs because it seemed like it kept coming back to the same thing, almost worded the exact same way, multiple times in one chapter. I think the feelings/thoughts of Destiny and the others were good and drove the story home, but it wasn't executed effectively or with restraint. I think there needed to be a pruning (can't think of a better way to describe it) to help the story and not have unnecessary words.
