A great book, effortless and detailed writing, the characterisation was natural and interesting, the plot wasn't half bad either and seemed to have been planned out and executed rather well if not slightly in a cliche manner (which wasn't always a bad thing). There was just the right amount of humour, intellect and suspense throughout *most* of the book. Some moments were predictable, cliche, even at times not quite believable, however for the most part there was a nice balance of elements.

I wanted to give *Forever With You* 4 stars, but couldn't quite manage it, as there were a few things that annoyed me or I didn't agree with. For starters, Tawny the female lead was a shy, sometimes un-confident and quiet person with not a lot of experience with anything. She was also a virgin, and that included with her shy personality kind of made Tawny and Kyle's "love scenes" not very believable; Tawny seemed far too confident, comfortable, and experienced for someone who is a shy virgin with no past experience with anything, especially not with sex. She turned into this sex-vixen instantly around Kyle, it just lacked believability. I really do not like it when characters completely change as soon as sex is involved.

I also didn't like the whole Aiden drama. Aiden was made out to be such a nice, genuine character in the beginning, and then suddenly he turns into a drunken almost-rapist? It just seemed far too fetched from the Aiden we first met, to the Aiden towards the end of the book. It was like the author conveniently made Aiden out to be a bad guy at the last minute just so it gave reason for Tawny and Kyle to re-unite. None of it seemed realistic, it was rather forced.

Communication was nil between Tawny and Kyle. The story dragged because there was no communication between those two characters; they bottled up their emotions, hid their thoughts from each other in regards to where they stood (would they remain friends, friends with benefits, or form a real relationship). If Tawny saw something she didn't like in relation to Kyle, like when girls would greet him/touch him/flirt with him, she'd hide how that made her feel and then ignore Kyle for days instead of expressing herself—which aggravated me, because a lot of the time the things she saw were misunderstandings, Tawny just liked to over-analyze and make assumptions. It was a little bit different with Kyle, because he really did try with Tawny, and it was a case of discovering and realising how you feel a little later than normal, but he was always trying to be there for Tawny and he wanted her to be more expressive rather than just ignore him when she didn't like something. Tawny was a bit of a coward, and only made the situation worse. And so, because of her choices to ignore rather than communicate, the story dragged on and on with unnecessary

suspense. Don't drag out a story that could have ended 20 chapters back—drawing it out isn't going to make it any better, it actually got to a point where I wanted to close the book and move on to something else.

Other than those three points, I did enjoy the story—but it was mainly the beginning and some of the middle, it was the ending where I took points away from. It helped that Renae Kelleigh is a good writer; there were lots of moments where I was impressed with her style of writing and the way she chose to go about things, realism was something that I enjoyed in this book. It's just the moments I mentioned above where she could use some work on, and then I think she'd be the perfect author!

I'll read something of Renae's again; she can only improve from here, and I look forward to it.
