Hot, sexy, and sweet! *Sam's Promise: Blackwater, Book 1* sets the stage for what looks to be a nice long series about the 5 hunky Jennings brothers. Carpenter/handy-man Sam (the oldest) and his four brothers (brainiac businessman Brodix (yeah, I said **Brodix**), construction company owner Vance, and younger twins Reilly and River) were rescued from the foster care system by their sweet but no nonsense adoptive mother Wanda (owner of the Blackwater Diner) and her late husband Chet. All the boys adore Wanda and are visiting her for a Thanksgiving dinner. Also invited to the dinner is curvy, dark haired beauty Julie Rose, a 29-year-old waitress at the diner and a part-time college student. Julie's getting a late start on her life, education and career due to many years caring for her terminally ill grandmother. Wanda invites sweet Julie in the hopes that one of her sons will see what a special young lady she is and then maybe sparks might fly? A Mom could hope... Well, all of her sons seem taken with Julie, but there's only one that makes Julie's heart flutter--and that is the rather gruff Sam. No complaints here about the romance--there was just the right amount of heat, naughty words, and dirty deeds between Sam and the less experienced (but enthusiastic) Julie.
