The characters are well-drawn, although at times a little extreme; the plot is sufficiently complex and clearly presented; the writing style is mostly smooth and skilled; the surprise ending was quite sudden and not foreshadowed, but it worked. The author does need to hire an editor who will get rid of many of the extraneous apostrophes scattered throughout.
