It's too spoilery to give more details, but basically Calla asks Gideon to go to Lightning Cove with her for a few days. Since he could seriously use a vacation, and he's got a huge crush on her, he agrees to go.

We knew Calla and Gideon were attracted to each other in the last book and you felt a romance *could be* brewing. In PoH, we learn they've been talking and meeting for coffee occasionally since the end of book #5,(mostly talking shop) but they haven't had a first date yet and beyond the short kiss Calla gave him in the last book nothing physical has been going on. Not even hand holding. Ms. Bateman can write an entertaining story, but romance? Not so much. Be prepared to go from zero to an unbelievable sixty in 2.5 seconds...or 172 pages. (Nothing sexually graphic, FYI)

Of course things are not at all what they seem, and Gideon is again in a life or death situation...and tortured. AGAIN. Man, does this author love to torture our poor Gideon. And Gideon always seems resigned to just *take it* for the greater good. Or the plan. Or whatever. Maybe he feels he deserves the pain?? I'm beginning to wonder.

The whole (view spoiler) thing was downright confusing. I didn't understand why at one point they had to obey Malphas, and at another, they could choose not to. Maybe a longer page count could have helped with this issue? Instead it felt contradictory and contrived just to aid the plot.

The premise was interesting, but it felt like several scenes were just rushed through to get to the end. The details were lacking here and consequently, my emotions didn't get fully engaged.

Will I read the next one? Yes. I still really like Gideon.
