What I found especially helpful about this book is the description of spirit guides in part 3. Rose covers the tools used in Spirit work, and gives some great exercises for developing and testing your skills. The section on giving readings and sittings is also very practical and took away a lot of the mystery (and trepidation) in performing this work for others. With her help, I believe I can do it!
