I do not appreciate the lack of respect the author gives her readers by offering a product containing editing errors. Missing words, misused words, spelling errors, and other editing errors were present in this work, although not as numerous as with many other e-book authors. These are unnecessary distractions. That said, I found this to be a great story well told. The protagonists both have physical challenges. Matt is a veteran who lost a leg in service to his country and Darcy was involved in an automobile accident that triggered epileptic seizures. Matt has adapted very well to his limitation, but Darcy still struggles, mostly because of the way many people react to a seizure. The way the author addresses these issues is both compassionate and revelatory, thus making this a story I can heartily recommend to my friends, despite my comments about editing errors.
