Very good memoir.

This was very well done and I found it quick and easy to read. The action flits between the past and the present and it was an engaging read.

I just had a quick peek at the first part of the book and was immediately gripped by an excellent opening chapter. Candace is just 5. It's 1971. I would have been 5 also in that year. I found it horrifying to think of being left outside a diner at such a young age to meet grandparents when they turned up hours later. Her mum was a single parent; her dad had died.

Candace had to bring herself up most of the time while her mum was pill popping. Now, after little care for herself, she is having to look after her mum as she is now older and failing. There are some surprising things-eg. the party and the man there. And her mother did nothing. Just tried to pass it off. Unbelievable.

I found a couple of things about the presentation a little disappointing: There is a mistake on the back cover: 'islandand' is shown as all one word which should be island and. Also, the cover text isn't centralised with the ropes of the swing. I wasn't sure if this was because I was reading an ARC uncorrected proof but the current back and front cover image is the same on the amazon listing. I feel this book deserved better attention to the cover. This doesn't affect my rating for the book, it was a very good memoir and I have given it a 5 star rating.
