Chalk up another hot read in the Bridgewater series from Vanessa Vale. I give this one 4 stars.

Abigail, who bears a burn scar on her face, has been away at finishing school in Butte for the past 2 years, sent there by her brother, James, her only living relative, where she met and befriended a girl named Tennessee. Her school friend lied when bragging about her wealthy family to handsome mine owner Paul Grimsby. Oh, the things we bring upon ourselves by lying! Mr. Grimsby then kills the girl's father, who's come to town for her graduation, and kidnaps Tennessee demanding money. When she admits her lie, he threatens to kill her too, until her friend Abigail steps in to try to save her. Her brother is a large land holder, and while most of his wealth is tied up in ranch land and cattle, she bargains with Grimsby to return in a week with money, or something he can sell for money, in order to save Tennessee's life.

As soon as she returns home, she attends a wedding and again notices the two men whom she's been crushing on since she was fourteen, stepbrothers Gabe and Tucker Landry, of Bridgewater. Now, at age nineteen, she realizes that this is much more than a crush, and, being familiar with the Bridgewater custom of men taking more than one wife, that knowledge and her attraction to both of them, makes them even more appealing. However, she feels that these two gorgeous men would never want her, viewing herself as rather plain and being extremely self-conscious about her facial scar. What she doesn't know is that Gabe and Tucker have had their eyes on her for years but never approached her because she was too young. When Abigail invents a fictitious beau, Aaron, back in Butte to make herself fit into the women's conversation and to give her a reason to return to Butte and pay off Tennessee's captors, the brothers are hesitant to approach her. When she explains that she intends to return to Aaron, James is too ill to accompany her, and Gabe and Tucker offer to escort her there instead, but when she admits that Aaron is not her fiance all bets are off and the two men take her to their home in Bridgewater instead, offering to marry her, something which creates even more problems with her deadline in Butte, and the need for even more lies.

You can always rely on Vanessa Vale and the Bridgewater series for a steamy menage romance read, and this addition to the series is no different in that regard, although Abigail is indeed the most brazen bride in this series. What I liked best about this short novel are the underlying themes of lying being so much worse than telling the truth, and the mistaken belief that a woman's self-esteem is only about her physical appearance. Although Abigail can scarcely believe it, Gabe and Tucker actually do see the wonderful woman she is behind her scar.

My only complaint, as ever, with this latest addition to the series is my perennial complaint about the books in this series--it's just too darn short. There is certainly enough material here for a full-length novel, and with each addition to Ms. Vale's Bridgewater series, I keep hoping she'll give the fans of this series what we all seem to want--more length, please!

Like all the other Bridgewater series books, Their Brazen Bride is full of steamy romance. As I absolutely loved all the other books in the series I had really high hopes for this one. However I have to say it didn't quiet leave as much of an impression as the others did.

Abigail Carr is a shy, soft-hearted, loving women, who knows exactly what she wants and that is to be the women between the two Landry brothers. She is really too nice for her own good, as she is always thinking about helping others. Due to the burn scar on her face for which she has always been made fun off, she is sure that no one can look past her scar to the real her. So she must go to Butte at all costs and rescue her friend, so that she may live a happy and fulfilling life with her men.

Tucker and Gabe Landry have loved Abigail since maybe before it was right to do so. However now that she

is back as a fully grown women, they will do whatever it takes to make her theirs. And while Abigail is determined to do everything on her own, she is theirs and they are determined to maker her see that she is not alone and she is not to ever put herself at risk.

While Their Brazen Bride is an amazing story, I feel the pace of the story was too fast, which in effect downplayed the conflicts of the story. If one is here only for the steamy sex scenes, then this story deserves a 5/5 however as a Vanessa Vale fan, I am a little disappointed with the plot, as I know that their is a lot of potential in this story, and that Ms. Vale could have done so much better. Instead of hurrying to the end, (which is the feeling I get when reading this book), I feel that the author should have placed more focus on Abigail's struggles, especially her inner struggle to accept the punishment meted out to her by her men. While it is true that Abigail has wanted the Landry Brothers since girlhood, through her determination to save her friend, she seems to be a women of strong independent character. However we didn't get to see her put much of a fight when receiving her punishment. While submission is a form of power, I had expected her to struggle a bit against being spanked like a child. However she immediately seems to give in. Even the men don't question her fully when she admits to them that she lied, they just move onto punishing her for doing so, which is not really what I had expected. Her brother allows her to travel to another town in the company of two men she isn't related to, which is unrealistic of the time, even if they showed interest in marrying her. The time period which Ms. Vale is trying to portray would be against doing such a thing.

Although this book is really great, both romance and sexiness vice, the plot wasn't as good for me and therefore to this book I shall give only a 3/5.
