Originally in France Angelique was printed as one massive book that was nearly 1200 pages. In the USA, the first two parts were issued as Angelique (880 pp) , and the third part as Angelique and the King (500 pp). In England, they were released as three separate books, each about 400 pages. So if you own an American copy of Angelique and are looking for part 2, this is part of the book you already own.

I give the book itself a 5, but because there is a real possibility that fans might get burnt by this edition, I have lowered the rating on the edition, solely for publishing issues. I also am uncertain if the same translator as the translator is uncredited on this edition. (Another serious failure as far as I am concerned.)
