Very text-heavy; wonderful illustrations--endpapers are especially nice with the gold leaf depictions of the Buddha. Often the pictures expand out of the rectangle container--dreams or other forces coming to interact with the story often depicted outside the boundaries she has set. Beautiful use of red throughout, lots of gold leaf, lots of contrast between bursts of color and pastels. Provided me a refresher course on Buddhism, the Four Noble Truths.
