I would LOVE for the German translation to actually use the polite forms which you can plainly see being used by the way the formal parts are drawn. I would love to see the sentences in the dramatic and tender scenes to not be monosyllabic but actually use the subject :P, but overall I am just happy I can get this as a licensed manga at all.
