She and her grandmother come to Kirkwood Lake to begin life anew. They have a vintage clothing store to start and will have twins to care for as Gianna is now carrying her husband's children. They were saved by being frozen embryos. The rest of Gianna's family knows nothing of what is going on.

Deputy Sheriff Seth Campbell just happens to have the perfect store front and apartment available for Gianna to rent. As they first meet when she and her grandmother arrive, there is an immediate attraction between them. However, Gianna is not looking for another husband and Seth is definitely not looking for another wife.
