I don't think I've read the other books in the Men of the Zodiac series, but I'm definitely going to check them out. You already know I love Entangled Publishing, especially the Indulgence line, so I'll be all over them.

Entrepreneur Nic Baldini is back in Florence seeking a position on a Board and set on proving to his father that he can make it on his own. He's a shoe-in for the position, but the committee that decides wants assurance that he will continue to sponsor local artists rather than shifting his focus to charities.

Babied by her entire family, Gia Carelli wants to pursue a career as an artist instead of the plan her family has in mind for her. It's instant sparks when Gia runs into Nic--and the pair can't keep away from each other. As they share some combustible moments together, Nic wants to protect himself from getting too close.

In less than two days, Gia had breached his defenses, and she hadn't even tried to. She seemed to want nothing from him, but the power that she could have over him if he let her frightened the hell out of him. I have control, and that isn't going to change.

He plans to be ther for only ten days. When he sees Gia's art, he can't help the reaction it stirs in him and he plans an exhibition for her work without revealing who he really is. He struggles with direction in life and not getting close enough to be burned. She doesn't know who he really is? When everything's out in the open, will they give in to each other and find their happily ever after?

I loved the setting of this book and definitely think Annie Seaton captured the feel and flair of Florence. I want to go back! I also really liked Gia, which surprised me. She was oppressed by her family for sure, but she definitely had something going on. Nic was sweet and tender with her, and I liked his dedication to his mother's memory and the promises he made her. He wanted to be so much more, and I can relate to that. And the two of them together--pretty hot.

I also enjoyed the family dynamics of both families, though I wanted to smack Gia's dad a few times.

There were some things that I didn't like. Though this couple was a perfectly imperfect match, I felt like Gia didn't assert herself enough. The pacing was a little slow and though they're on a time table, I felt like I skimmed parts. There was also an overuse of the words "moist" and "moisture"--you know how I feel about that.
