

Now it wasn't great literature but since this is menage erotica it had enough plot to hang the story on. The writing was just okay. It was fairly obvious that this is a new writer. I would be willing to read more by her to watch her improve if any were available but I couldn't find any. The cowboys talked in vernacular if that sort of thing bothers you.

The sex scenes were pretty good and pretty plentiful. My biggest complaint was that everyone on the ranch was okay with the sharing. The foreman's wife and other wives were all "more power to ya girl". Now I know this is erotica and fiction but I would have much prefered to see a serious attempt made to show how a menage such as this would have been accepted in real life.
